**Texas Society of CPAs Announces New Officers to Serve
on Executive Board**

Mark D. Lee Named Chairman of 27,000-Member Texas Society of CPAs

DALLAS — Houston tax attorney and certified public accountant Mark D. Lee was recently elected chairman of the 27,000-member Texas Society of Certified Public Accountants (TSCPA).

Lee will serve a one-year term as the Society's volunteer leader and will chair the organization's board of directors, which sets policy, manages programs and oversees activities designed to serve Texas CPAs.

Lee is Deputy General Counsel in the Legal Department of AIG Life & Retirement. He is a tax attorney in addition to a CPA. He is an active member of a number of professional organizations including the Houston Society of Certified Public Accountants (Immediate Past President), and Ascend (the National Asian American Society of Accountants – current Board member). Lee is also a member of the State Bar of Texas, the Houston Bar Association (Past Chair of the Houston Bar Association's Tax Section), the National Asian Pacific Bar Association, and the Asian American Bar Association of Houston.

Lee received his BBA in accounting from the University of Texas at Austin and his JD from the University of Houston Law Center.
